Security Advice

While the chances of being burgled remain small, there are things you can do to improve your security and minimise the risk even further. Being a Guardian - looking out for your neighbours and reporting anything suspicious, is key.



CHECK...LOCK

 Keep front and back doors locked at all times - even when you are at home or in the garden. 1 in 4 burglaries are through insecure doors or windows!

CHECK...OUT OF SIGHT

• Keep keys out of sight and reach from cat flaps, letterboxes and downstairs doors and windows.

CHECK...LIGHTS

 If you are out in the evening make sure you leave a light on and draw the curtains. If it's dark before you get home, use timer switches to turn on the lights.
